Explaining Corporate Worship

Invocation: As we gather to worship God, we, His church, call upon Him to serve us from heaven

Votum: Our covenant Lord responds through the Trinitarian blessing of his ordained ambassador

Confession of Faith: We confess to God and to each other our common faith in the Lord Jesus Christ

Singing doxology: We sing praise to our Triune God for His blessing of salvation to us

Reading of the law: God speaks to us in His moral law to reveal our sin so that we convicted and humbled, and turn to our heavenly Father in faith, confessing our sins

Prayer of confession: We confess to God how we have sinned against Him in thought, word and deed - in that which we have done and that which we have left undone.
