For your meditation this Lord's Day:

*“[Christ] is finite and infinite; ignorant and omniscient; less than than God and equal with God; He existed from eternity and he was born in time; He created all things and He was a man of sorrows. It is on this principle, that we what is true of either nature is true of the person, that multitude of passages of Scripture are to be explained... The forms of expression, therefore, long prevalent in the Church, “the blood of God,” “God the mighty maker died,” etc., are in accordance with Scriptural usage... The person born of the Virgin Mary was a divine person. He was the Son of God. It is therefore correct to say that Mary was the mother of God.” (Charles Hodge, ST, 2:292-93)*

*“Here is something marvelous: the Son of God descended from heaven in such a way that, without leaving heaven, he willed to be borne in the virgin's womb, to go about the earth, and to hang upon the cross; yet he continuously filled the world even as he had done from the beginning!” (Calvin, Inst. 2.13.4)*
